

Privacy policy

On this page we inform you in detail about the handling of your data through our website and the tools and services of external providers used on it. We respect your personal data and your privacy not only out of legal obligation, but also out of personal conviction. For example, we ensure the protection of your data through regular updates and security techniques such as encryption.

Data collection on our website

Who is responsible for data collection on this website?

The data processing on this website is carried out by the website operator. His contact details can be found in the imprint of this website.

How do we collect your data?

On the one hand, your data is collected when you provide it to us. This can be data that you enter in a contact form, for example.

Other data is automatically collected by our IT systems when you visit the website. These are mainly technical data (e.g. internet browser, operating system or time of the page call).

What do we use your data for?

Part of the data is collected to ensure that the website is provided without errors. Other data can be used to analyse your user behaviour.

What rights do you have regarding your data?

You have the right to receive information free of charge about the origin, recipient and purpose of your stored personal data at any time. You also have the right to demand the correction, blocking or deletion of this data. For this purpose, as well as for further questions regarding data protection, you can contact us at any time at the address given in the imprint. Furthermore, you have a right of appeal to the responsible supervisory authority.

Analysis tools and third-party tools

When you visit our website, your Internet activity behaviour can be statistically evaluated. This is mainly done with cookies and with so-called analysis programs. The analysis of your Internet activity behaviour is usually anonymous; the Internet activity behaviour cannot be traced back to you. You can object to this analysis or prevent it by not using certain tools. We will inform you about the possibilities of objection in this privacy policy.

Company data protection officer

Due to the circumstances, we are not subject to the mandatory appointment of a company data protection officer, according to §38 Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) new and Article 37 GDPR (DSGVO).

Right to information, revocation, blocking, correction, deletion, data transfer

You can request information about the data stored about you at the above address of the person responsible.

If you have given separate consent to the processing of personal data, you can revoke your consent at any time. By revoking your consent, the data processed until the revocation remains lawfully processed. The revocation of consent must be declared to the same body to which you have given your consent.

In addition, under certain circumstances, you can demand the correction or deletion of your data. You may have the right to limit the processing of your data, as well as the right to have the data provided by you released in a structured, common and machine-readable format.

Right to appeal to the competent supervisory authority

As the person concerned, you have the right to complain to the responsible supervisory authority in the event of a violation of data protection laws. The competent supervisory authority regarding data protection issues is the State Data Protection Commissioner of the federal state in which our company is located. Objection against advertising mails

Data collection on our website SSL or TLS encryption

For security reasons and to protect the transmission of confidential content that you send to us as the site operator, our website uses SSL or TLS encryption. This means that data that you transmit via this website cannot be read by third parties. You can recognize an encrypted connection by the "https://" address line of your browser and the lock symbol in the browser line.

Server log files

In server log files, the provider of the website automatically collects and stores information that your browser automatically sends to us. These are:

- Browser type and version
- Operating system used

- Referrer URL (access status/http status code)
- Hostname of the accessing computer
- Date and time of the server request, as well as the time zone
- IP address
- Transmitted data volume

This data is not merged with other data sources. The basis for data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b EU Data Protection Basic Regulation (DSGVO), which permits the processing of data for the fulfilment of a contract or pre-contractual measures. The data is deleted when it is no longer required.

Contact form

Data transmitted via the contact form will be stored including your contact data in order to be able to process your inquiry or to be available for follow-up questions. These data will not be passed on without your consent.

The processing of the data entered in the contact form is based exclusively on your consent (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a DSGVO). A revocation of your already given consent is possible at any time. An informal notification by e-mail is sufficient for the revocation. The legality of the data processing operations carried out until the revocation remains unaffected by the revocation.

Data transmitted via the contact form will remain with us until you request us to delete it, revoke your consent to its storage or until there is no longer any need for data storage. Mandatory legal provisions - in particular, retention periods - remain unaffected.

Newsletter

If you would like to receive the newsletter offered on the website, we need an e-mail address from you as well as information that allows us to verify that you are the owner of the e-mail address provided and that you agree to receive the newsletter. Further data will not be collected or only on a voluntary basis. We use these data exclusively for sending the requested information and do not pass them on to third parties.

The processing of the data entered in the newsletter registration form is based exclusively on your consent (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a DSGVO). You can revoke your consent to the storage of the data, the e-mail address as well as its use for sending the newsletter at any time, e.g. via the "unsubscribe" link in the newsletter. The legality of the data processing operations already carried out remains unaffected by the revocation.

The data you have provided us with for the purpose of subscribing to the newsletter will be stored by us until you unsubscribe from the newsletter and deleted after you have cancelled your subscription. Data that has been stored by us for other purposes (e.g. e-mail addresses for the member area) remains unaffected

Google Web Fonts
